Drawing Materials

- 2B Pencil, Wood or mechanical and any others you have on hand
- Magic Rub or kneaded eraser
- Tracing Paper (9x12 or 11x15)
- Artist's low-tack tape

Painting Materials

- 1 quarter sheet (11x15), 140 lb Hot Press watercolor paper (I prefer Arches brand) or a watercolor block of similar size or you can purchase from me for \$2
- Professional Grade watercolor paint , small tubes (I prefer Winsor Newton)
 - Payne's Gray (Winsor Newton brand)
- Round Brushes, #2, #4, and #8 preferred
- Sturdy clean board or plexiglass (11x15 or slightly larger) to use as a painting surface
- 2 small containers for water (clean cottage cheese or yogurt containers)
- Small white plastic palette for mixing colors – 10 wells w/cover works well
- Paper towels

Additional Materials

- Magnifying glass (optional)
- Scrap watercolor paper for testing colors
- Sketch pad for notes and sketches
