Subject: Temporary Intoxicating Liquor License – Chamber of Commerce Taste of Edina

Action Requested:

Approve the Temporary On-Sale Intoxicating Liquor License and Special Permit to use city property. The two permits will be used in conjunction with one another during the “Taste of Edina” event.

Information / Background:

The Edina Chamber of Commerce has applied for a Temporary On-Sale Intoxicating Liquor License and Special Permit to use city property to hold their annual “Taste of Edina” event. The event will be held at Centennial Lakes, Hughes Pavilion, 7499 France Avenue, on May 16th, 2013 between 4:30-7:30 p.m.

The applicants estimate approximately 500 attendees. The applicants have provided a security plan which includes: the hiring of police officer(s) for security purposes, the use of ropes/gates as physical barriers separating the licensed premises, and servers will be of proper age. Historically, the “Taste of Edina” event poses little public safety concern.

I recommend the Temporary Liquor License/Special Permit be approved with the condition that the sale and consumption of intoxicating beverages be limited to beer and wine.
