Subject: St. Patrick's Catholic Church, Temporary On-sale Intoxicating Liquor License	

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approve the Temporary Intoxicating Liquor License for the Church of St. Patrick's. The license requested is for an event titled "St. Patrick's Day Celebration".

INFORMATION/BACKGROUND:

The Church of St. Patrick has applied for a Temporary Intoxicating Liquor License for their St. Patrick's Day Celebration event. The event will be held on March 17, 2012 from 6:15 PM to 9:00 PM in the St. Patrick's Social Hall and the adjoining kitchen.

The applicants are eligible for the Liquor License and have submitted plans to meet the special requirements for a Temporary License under City Code. In addition, they have gone beyond these requirements by not allowing anyone under 21 years old to serve alcohol. Minnesota state law only mandates servers to be 18 years old. The Church of St. Patrick has hired an Edina Police Officer to provide security for this event.

All Temporary Intoxicating Liquor Licenses that have been issued to this church in the past have gone smoothly with no complaints to the police department.
