Subject: 50th & France District Improvements – Weekly Construction Content

All:

Here is the project construction information update for the weeks of July 7 and July 14, 2014:

WEEK OF JULY 7, 2014:

For the week of July 7, construction will continue in the South Ramp and around the Clancy's surface parking lot at 49 ½ Street and Halifax Avenue. Parking structure restoration activities will continue in the South Ramp on the second and third levels. No more than 60 parking stalls will be out of service in the South Ramp at any time. Some construction activities on the second level may require additional stall closures on the first level of the ramp for short durations. Nearly 900 parking ramp stalls will be available in the 50th & France District each day during construction. Pedestrian access to all businesses will remain open. Streetscape construction activities will include irrigation system installation and concrete paver replacement.

WEEK OF JULY 14, 2014:

For the week of July 14, construction will continue in the South Ramp. Parking structure restoration activities will continue in the South Ramp on the second and third levels. No more than 60 parking stalls will be out of service in the South Ramp at any time. Nearly 900 parking ramp stalls will be available in the 50th & France District each day during construction. Streetscape construction activities will continue within the pedestrian plaza on the south side of the Center Ramp. Construction activities will include concrete paver replacement.

In anticipation for the 50th & France Crazy Days and Esprit de She events, no construction will occur from July 17 – July 20.

Please help the Contractor keep the work zone safe their workers and the traveling public by slowing down, staying out of construction areas, observing traffic control signs and exercising patience.
