For the past two years, the City has been planning improvements to the Promenade area, from the north end of Centennial Lakes to the Galleria on 70th.

Work will commence on this exciting project in early May. This will include re-grading, installation of the pedestrian and bicycle pathways, and landscaping. Because of the use of heavy equipment, the Promenade will be closed for the entire summer through November for safety reasons. We apologize for this inconvenience, and hope that you will enjoy the newly renovated pathways and amenities next spring.
