Dear Area Resident:

The City of Edina has awarded the Promenade Phase II construction project to Lunda Construction Company. As you are well aware, the contractor has already begun work on removing the old walkway under York Avenue South. Crews will work this summer to install new northbound and southbound structural bridges over the Promenade area and extend the pathway east York Avenue.

At this time, they are currently working on removing the existing walkway under York Avenue. Crews will then begin to build the first bridge on the northbound lane of York Avenue. Once this side is complete, they will switch traffic over to use the new bridge, and begin working on constructing the west bridge. Crews have erected signage to show where walkways have been closed due to the projects work in progress. These limits are defined with an orange fence. For everyone's safety, please stay outside the construction limits.

The City of Edina has contracted with URS to design and manage the construction project process. If you have any questions, feel free to contact URS project manager, Greg Brown, at 612-370-0700, or you can contact the construction inspector, Linda Battey, at 612-373-6810.
