ITEM 3 - Transportation Study

Proposed Summary Statement –The City of Edina seeks to understand the existing transportation networks in and around the Grandview area to inform decision-making on short-term and long-term infrastructure improvements. This study will gather and collect available data such as: vehicle counts, pedestrian & bicyclist counts, peak periods, accident data, age and condition of infrastructure. Gaps, congestion points and safety concerns should be identified. General recommendations for cost-effective improvements should be provided. The second phase of this study will be to compare the existing performance with the future performance, assuming that the concepts in the “Development Framework” will be fully realized.
