54th Street Reconstruction

Dear Resident:

54th Street Bridge

Site safety is extremely important during bridge construction. Do not attempt to cross safety fences or access the creek while the bridge is under construction. Crews will install bridge railings and sidewalks over the next few weeks. Site clean-up will begin next week in anticipation of tying in the road work with the bridge.

Completion of the bridge to allow traffic over the creek is approximately six weeks away.

54th Street

Road crews will continue grading and removing gravel for use in other areas of the project. Access will be maintained during this work with minor localized impacts.

All schedules are weather-dependent and are subject to change.

Pedestrians and bicyclists: please use the existing bridge located just north of 54th Street in Arden Park near the shelter.

Site safety is extremely important during bridge construction. Do not attempt to cross safety fences or access the creek while the bridge is under construction.
