Arden Park D Neighborhood Street Reconstruction

Dear Resident:

54th Street Bridge

Site safety is extremely important during bridge construction. Do not attempt to cross safety fence or access the creek while the bridge is under construction.

Pedestrians and bicyclists: please use the existing bridge located just north of 54th Street in Arden Park near the shelter.

The contractor has experienced repeated vandalism to construction equipment near the bridge. If you see any activity in the construction area after working hours or on weekends, please call the Edina Police Department at 952-826-1600. Thank you for your help.

Project Schedule: Stage 1

The first round of paving is complete. There is a small lip at the curb edge and driveway aprons; this is normal. The final layer of asphalt will be placed later this fall when all project restoration behind the curb is complete.

Next week, crews will continue boulevard restoration, including irrigation and pet fence repairs, grading and topsoil placement, plant replacement and sidewalk installation. Please refrain from hiring an independent company to repair your damaged irrigation and pet fence systems as the City will not reimburse you for the cost of the repairs.

Project Schedule: Stage 2

Next week, crews will finish removing curbs, gutters and driveway aprons. The roadway will be open during the process with isolated closures in areas where crews are working. Please use caution when driving through these areas.

Project Schedule: Stage 3

Next week, crews will continue to install water and sewer services, and a storm sewer pipe on Halifax Avenue. Upon completion of the new water services, crews will contact affected homes to switch from the temporary water service and to the new water main.

Grading preparation for curbs and gutters will begin on Gorgas Avenue next week. Crews are scheduled to begin work in the alley between Minnehaha Boulevard and Halifax Avenue. Properties abutting the alley will be given at least one day's notice in advance of any work that will occur.

General

Remember, on-site parking will not be allowed in areas where crews are actively working. All stage schedules are weather-dependent and are subject to change.
