Dear Resident:

This project is for bike boulevard improvements which will include signing, striping and traffic circles and is scheduled to begin Thursday, September 6. The project is funded by a grant through Transit for Livable Communities (TLC). The designated bike boulevard streets are:

- 54th Street between Wooddale Avenue and Zenith Avenue
- Wooddale Avenue between 50th Street and Highway 62
- Valley View Road between Wooddale Avenue and 64th Street
- Southdale Road between Highway 62 and 68th Street
- Cornelia Drive between 68th Street and 70th Street

On Thursday, the contractor will begin installing the traffic circles on 54th at Drew Avenue and Beard Avenue. Some preparation work has already been completed by Public Works. While each street is being striped parking will not be allowed and no parking signs will be posted.

Communication

Our primary communication with you will be done using City Extra e-mail. This service is free and allows you to sign up to receive e-mail messages from the City on a variety of topics.
