Braemar Hills Neighborhood Roadway Improvements

Dear Resident:

The following is a quick update of the project in your neighborhood:

Private Utility Reconstruction Schedule

CenterPoint Energy has finished all of its upgrades in the neighborhood. CenturyLink and Comcast should be finished in the next few weeks. Xcel Energy will upgrade the light pole on Gleason Circle at no cost to residents.

Neighborhood Reconstruction Schedule

Next week, Northwest Asphalt will replace water main valves and fire hydrants on St. Patrick's Lane, Tupa Circle, Tupa Drive and Scotia Drive, and install a new water main in the Tupa Circle and Tupa Drive cul-de-sacs. They will also upgrade the storm sewer catch basins.

To complete water main work, the water to your home may be shut off. If so, the contractor will notify you a day in advance. Crews will work to get the water system turned back on as soon as possible.

Water main work and hydrant replacements may cause rust-colored water to come out of your faucets. This is normal and the water is safe to drink, though you should wait until the water is clear again before doing a load of laundry. Flush all your faucets at the same time to remove the reddish color, beginning with the laundry room sink.

Important notice for residents on St. Patrick's Lane

Water lines in this area are connected to the Church of St. Patrick, which operates a day care. To minimize the impact on business operations, a shut-off of the water main in your area will take place at 6 p.m. Monday, May 13. The contractor will notify affected residents May 12 by hanging a notice on front doors. Water service should be restored by 9 p.m.
