Braemar Hills / Gleason Circle / St. Patricks Lane Neighborhood Roadway Improvements

Dear Resident:

The following is a quick update of the project in your neighborhood:

Private Utility Reconstruction Schedule

Comcast should be finished with its upgrades next week. Xcel Energy will upgrade the light pole on Gleason Circle at no cost to residents once the concrete curb and gutters are replaced. CenturyLink has started its work on Gleason Circle and will move to Tupa and Scotia drives the week of May 27.

Neighborhood Reconstruction Schedule

Two new water mains were installed on Tupa Circle and Tupa Drive and will be tested before they're used to provide water to residents. Besides the sump drain lines, utility work on St. Patrick's Lane is finished; Gleason Circle should be completed next week.

Northwest Asphalt will replace water main valves and fire hydrants on Tupa and Scotia drives and begin storm sewer upgrades on Gleason Circle, Tupa Drive and Scotia Drive next week.

To complete water main work, the water to your home may be shut off. If so, the contractor will notify you a day in advance. Crews will work to get the water system turned back on as soon as possible.
