Bredesen Park D Neighborhood Roadway Improvements

Dear Resident:

Neighborhood Reconstruction Schedule

The week of June 2, crews will be lining some of the sanitary sewer trunk pipes in the neighborhood.

If you live on these streets where lining will occur, you will be without sewer service for up to 12 hours. We request that you do not use the shower, wash clothes, do dishes and limit flushing your toilet. The contractor will notify you using a door hanger of the exact date and time of the work.

If you receive a notification of this work, please pour one gallon of water down every drain to fill your plumbing traps with water. This will prevent odors associated with cured-in-place pipe work from entering your home through your private sewer service pipe. You will notice a cloud of steam from the work area and you may smell an odor similar to that in a hair salon or auto body shop. This is normal.

Previously, a decision was made to rebuild the watermain system and watermain services within the Bredesen Park D project area. The additional watermain work will be funded with the water utility fund and will not impact project assessments.

Crews from Palda & Sons, Inc. will soon begin installing a temporary water main pipe to your home. The pipe will temporarily supply water to the homes while crews complete water main repairs. The contractor may need to enter these homes to operate the water shut-off valve in the basement. Palda & Sons will use a doorknob hanger or knock on your door, on a case-by-case basis, to notify affected homes. Please be careful when cutting grass near the temporary water service pipe. If applicable, please pass this warning along to your lawn service.

While being provided water from the temporary water main, you may notice your tap water is warmer than usual. This is normal and is caused by the fact that the water main is above ground and subject to ambient air temperatures.
