Bredesen Park D Neighborhood Roadway Improvements

Dear Resident:

Construction is beginning in your neighborhood!

Neighborhood Reconstruction Schedule

Palda & Sons, Inc. is making water main upgrades on Tamarac Avenue, Tamarac Lane and Aspen Road. Please continue to watch for water shutoff notices on your front door. We will make every effort to limit the number of times the water is shut off.

Water main work and hydrant replacements may cause rust-colored water to come out of your faucets. This is normal and the water is safe to drink, though you should wait until the water is clear again before doing a load of laundry. Flush all your faucets at the same time to remove the reddish color, beginning with the laundry room sink.

Palda & Sons will also start installing a new sump drain tile line behind the curb, which will be connected to the new storm sewer system. According to City Code, all residents with sump pumps and roof drains who discharge at the curb or within the right-of-way should use this service pipe. Please call or email me if you have any questions.

Palda & Sons hopes to have all the underground utilities finished by the end of next week for Tamarac Avenue, Tamarac Lane and Aspen Road. Once these are finished, they will focus on grading the streets and preparing for the new curb and gutter installation. They will also continue with utility work on Walnut Drive at that time. Notices pertaining to parking will be distributed then.
