## Countryside H Neighborhood Roadway Improvements

Dear Resident:

The following is an update on the project status for private utility upgrades in your neighborhood.

### Private Utility Reconstruction Schedule

As part of the neighborhood reconstruction process, private utility companies have started to upgrade their infrastructure. The upgrades include replacing gas mains and services to your home, replacing electrical conduit and moving power poles. Please note that these private utility upgrades are not directly associated with the City or the neighborhood reconstruction project.

CenterPoint Energy has hired its own contractor to complete the upgrades, prior to the start of our reconstruction project. It will have their own project superintendents on-site to coordinate these upgrades.

The following is a preliminary schedule for private utility upgrades:

- CenterPoint Energy – Crews will upgrade gas main and service lines at various locations throughout the neighborhood. You will be contacted by CenterPoint Energy's subcontractor, Michels, if crews need to upgrade the service line to your home.
- CenturyLink – No upgrades are scheduled.
- Comcast – No upgrades are scheduled.
- Xcel Energy – Crews will mobilize in the coming weeks to move conflicting power poles and move/install street lights.

Restoration of any disturbed lawn areas within the right-of-way will be completed later this year as part of the neighborhood reconstruction project.

### Neighborhood Reconstruction Schedule

A neighborhood preconstruction kick-off meeting will be held 5 p.m. Monday, April 20 in the Countryside Elementary School parking lot. Up-to-date information on the project will be shared and staff from the City and the contractor will be available to answer your questions.

Work on your neighborhood reconstruction project is scheduled to begin with Stage I (Olinger Circle, Sun Road and Amy Drive) in early May.

If you have decided to upgrade the sewer and water services to your home, this work must be completed within the right-of-way no later than May 11. Around this time, crews will begin grading the streets and upgrading the public infrastructure. Please share this information with your contractor.
