Countryside H Neighborhood Roadway Improvements

Dear Resident:

Private Utility Reconstruction Schedule:

- CenterPoint Energy has finished work in the neighborhood. Restoration in areas that are affected by the City's reconstruction project will be completed later this summer.
- Xcel Energy is in the process of installing new wiring to street lights. Street lights on Phase I are planned to be replaced in the same locations.

Project Schedule:

Phase 1 (includes Olinger Circle, Sun Road and Amy Drive)

- Boulevards, irrigation systems and pet fences will be repaired during the restoration phase of the project. In the next few weeks, crews will work on irrigation systems and pet fences. In order for the contractor to work on irrigation systems, they will need someone to be home to turn on the water.
- Crews have installed the hydroseeding a couple weeks ago and will complete the rest of the hydroseeding with Phase 2.

Phase 2 (includes Arbour Avenue, Stuart Avenue, Benton Avenue, and Grove Street east of Arbour Avenue)

- Crews have placed some sidewalks, curbs and driveways aprons. Remember that the concrete will need at least five days to cure before driving on them.
- Concrete crews will be here until next week to work on the sidewalks at Benton and Arbour avenues.
- Next, the road will be prepped for pavement. During this work, please do not park on the streets.

Phase 3 (includes Merold Drive, Wycliff Road, and Grove Street west of Arbour Avenue)

- Beginning July 20, the intersection of Wycliff Road and Merold Drive will be closed for pipe bursting, and could remain closed for a few days. Water will also be shut-off and notice will be distributed to those affected. Anticipate water shut off next week.
- Work has started on gate valve and hydrant assemblies on Wycliffe Road, Grove Street and Merold Drive.
- Crews have started work on utilities in Phase 3.
- Residents will have limited access on certain roads and to driveways starting next week. If you have anything planned and you would to coordinate access, please let me know ahead of time.
- Remember to routinely check your front door for time-sensitive notices. All schedules are weather dependent and are subject to change.
