## **Countryside H Neighborhood Roadway Improvements**

Dear Resident:

### **Project Schedule:**

#### **Phase 1** (includes Olinger Circle, Sun Road and Amy Drive)

- Restoration is still on-going. Reseeding will occur in certain areas as needed.

#### **Phase 2** (includes Arbour Avenue, Stuart Avenue, Benton Avenue, and Grove Street east of Arbour Avenue)

- Restoration is still on-going. Reseeding will occur in certain areas as needed.

#### **Phase 3** (includes Merold Drive, Wycliffe Road, and Grove Street west of Arbour Avenue)

- Restoration crews have been in the area repairing sprinkler systems and pet fences that were damaged during construction. If yours has not yet been repaired, please email me.
- Starting Oct. 20, the contractor will begin lining the sanitary sewer. You may notice a cloud of steam from the work area and you may smell an odor while the pipes are being worked on. The smell comes from the hot water or steam being used to cure a resin on the newly installed pipe in the sewer main. This is normal.
- The equipment used for the cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) process makes it difficult for vehicles to drive by the work zone. Please do not park on either side of the road and use caution when driving in areas while crews are working. The process is complete and the connections re-established when there is no more work on the street at the end of the day.

Remember to routinely check your front door for time-sensitive notices. All schedules are weather-dependent and are subject to change.
