Project Schedule

Remember, on-street parking during reconstruction is not allowed in areas where crews are working.

This week, crews installed the new water main along Hyde Park Lane. Crews also started the installation of the sump drain along Bonne Brae Drive, Hyde Park Circle and Hyde Park Drive. The upgrades and repairs to the storm sewer along Bonnie Brae Drive were also completed.

Restoration crews continue to work in the Prospect Knolls project area. The patches along Dewey Hill Road were installed.

Later next week, crews will mobilize to Hyde Park Lane to begin the process of upgrading the storm pipe that runs from Hyde Park Lane to Hyde Park North Pond. During this time, Hyde Park Lane will be reduced to one narrow lane. The following week, crews will need to close Hyde Park Lane for two to three days to complete the work. Please watch your front doors for flyers instructing you with more detail on accessibility and parking.

Crews will continue to work on utility upgrades throughout the project area.

Remember to routinely check your front door for time-sensitive notices. All schedules are weather-dependent and are subject to change.
