## Lake Edina Neighborhood Roadway Reconstruction

Dear Resident:

### Neighborhood Reconstruction Schedule – Stage 1

Crews are working to hydro-seed disturbed lawn areas. Please watch your front doors for information on the hydro-seeding process and long-term care tips. Crews will continue to work on-site cleanup and miscellaneous restoration items.

### Neighborhood Reconstruction Schedule – Stage 2

Crews will continue working on restoration efforts as things wrap up in Stage 1. Crews will begin repairing pet fences and irrigation systems disturbed by construction activities, as well as restoring any blacktop driveways. Please watch your front doors for notices if the contractors need to set up repair schedules.

### Neighborhood Reconstruction Schedule – Stage 3

Good news! All utility work should wrap this afternoon. We do not anticipate any more water shutoffs or major digging in the neighborhood other than roadway grading.

Grading crews will continue to grade your street. Notices regarding to parking restrictions will be distributed, as access to your homes during the day will be limited. The roadway will close during the grading process in areas where crews are working. At the end of the workday, crews will reopen the roadway and access to your driveway. If you have any special needs or questions, feel free to ask one of the workers or me for assistance.

The contractor will repair any damage to irrigation or pet fence systems during the restoration phase of the project in a few weeks.
