## Lake Edina Neighborhood Roadway Improvements

Dear Resident:

The following is a quick update of the project in your neighborhood:

### Neighborhood Reconstruction Schedule – Stage I

Palda & Son's, Inc. is making water main upgrades on West Shore Drive near Poppy Lane. Please continue to watch for water shut-off notices on your front door. We will make every effort to limit the number of times the water is shut off.

Water main work and hydrant replacements may cause rust-colored water to come out of your faucets. This is normal and the water is safe to drink, though you should wait until the water is clear again before doing a load of laundry. Flush all your faucets at the same time to remove the reddish color, beginning with the laundry room sink.

Palda & Son's, Inc. is also installing a new sump drain tile line behind the existing curb, which will be connected to the existing storm sewer system. All residents with sump pumps and roof drains who discharge at the curb or within the right-of-way should use this service. Please contact me with any questions.

Crews will soon regrade portions of the roadway on West Shore Drive between Hibiscus Avenue and Poppy Lane. Notices pertaining to parking will be distributed.

### Notice for residents near West Shore Drive and Poppy Lane

Water lines in the area are connected to the Burgundy Place mixed-use development off of West 77th Street. To minimize the impact on business operations, the water main will be shut off at 2 p.m. today, May 10. Water service should be restored by 9 p.m.

Next week, crews will replace water main valves and fire hydrants on Sedum Lane and Kellogg Avenue. To complete this work, the water to your home will need to be shut off. If the shut off affects you, the contractor will notify you a day in advance by hanging a notice on your front door.

### Private Utility Reconstruction Schedule

A Comcast subcontractor, D&D Service, is upgrading cable services on West Shore Drive and Poppy Lane.

A CenterPoint Energy subcontractor, Michels Corp., has completed some gas main and service upgrades and will continue these on Phlox Lane and Monardo Lane. Please watch for correspondence from Michels.
