Lake Edina Neighborhood Roadway Reconstruction

Dear Resident:

Neighborhood Reconstruction Schedule – All Stages

Wednesday night, a water main broke on Hibiscus Avenue between Monardo and Phlox Lanes. The break was not related to the work completed by Palda & Sons, Inc. Edina's Public Works Department completed the repair and have backfilled the area.

Public Works will soon install a temporary bituminous asphalt patch on the roadway. We recommend a permanent fix be completed next spring when the exact extent of the damage can be determined. To ensure a proper fix, the underlying soils need to be dried and compacted. Due to the amount of water and typical fall weather, we feel the ability to correctly repair the road would be extremely difficult this time of year.

All costs associated with this repair will be funded by the utility fund. Residents will not be assessed for this work.

On Monday, Oct. 21, crews will begin performing a "saw-and-seal" treatment to the new bituminous pavement surface. This treatment helps control expansion and contraction of the pavement. In cold-weather climates, all blacktop pavements expand and contract when they endure freeze-thaw cycles. Dust will be created when the saws are operating, but the contractor will follow the work with a sweeper truck.

The work will take a few days to complete throughout the entire project area. Once the saw-and-seal crews have completed their tasks in front of your home, the roadway will reopen for parking as usual. Please do not park any vehicles on the street the morning of the work as the entire roadway will need to be clear for crews.
