





## Morningside A and White Oaks C Neighborhood Roadway Reconstruction

Dear Resident:

### Project Schedule:

- Next week, crews will install concrete curbs and gutters on Curve Avenue and Sunnyside Road. The following day, concrete driveway aprons will be poured. To allow enough time for the concrete to cure, driveways will be inaccessible for three days. The contractor will notify affected homeowners with a door hanger the day before the work occurs, which will list alternative parking areas. Between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m., vehicles will be allowed to park on the street. Driveways will re-open once the concrete cures and a gravel ramp is added.
- Next week crews will begin removing curb and gutter and driveway aprons on Townes Road and Townes Circle. A gravel ramp will be built so that you can access your driveway.
- After sections of the driveway are removed, the contractor will begin to place an above-ground temporary water piping system in the boulevards. The pipes will be buried at each driveway to allow continued access. The system will supply water to each house while the water mains and services in the street are being replaced. This system will connect to each house at the outside hose bib via a pipe similar to a garden hose shown in the photo below.



- You may notice your tap water is warmer than usual. This is normal and happens because the water pipe is above ground rather than below. Additionally, water main reconstruction may cause rust-colored water. This, too, is normal. Flush your faucets by running all of them at the same time for several minutes and this will remove the rust color.
- Also, depending on your house plumbing, your water softener may not work while you are connected to the temporary water system. If you have questions about your water softener, please call the number on the doorknob hanger. Please be careful of these above ground pipes when cutting your grass.
- Please be careful to not move or bump the above ground temporary water pipes as it can cause leaks.
- Signs for Sunnyside Road business access are in place directing customers to use the 44th Street alley.
- Please put your garbage and/or recycling out prior to 7 a.m. on your collection day as haulers are trying to complete their rounds before road work is started for the day.
