Morningside A and White Oaks C Neighborhood Roadway Reconstruction

Dear Resident:

Project Schedule:

- Paving on West 45th Street and Grimes Avenue is scheduled for next week. A notice will be placed at your front door at least one day prior to the paving. You will not be able to park on the street while the street is being paved. Paving crews move fast and you will be able to drive on the new pavement about 15 minutes after it is compacted with a rolling machine. Paving crews will direct you around the paving operations as required.
- Early next week, crews will place a new sanitary sewer pipe on Sunnyside Road between Townes Road and Curve Avenue. During this time, it is best to limit your water use. A crew member will knock on your door before the work begins to communicate the schedule and any special requests. This will close access to driveways for approximately one working day. A notice will be placed at your front door the day prior to the work.
- Later in the week, crews will place new water main pipes on Sunnyside Road between Grimes Avenue and Curve Avenue. Due to this work, Sunnyside Road will be closed periodically, please obey the road closed signs for the safety of the workers. This will close access to driveways for approximately one working day. A notice will be placed at your front door the day prior to the work.
- Signs for Sunnyside Road business access are in place directing customers to use the 44th^h Street alley.
- On several occasions, the contractor has noticed that construction signs have been moved at night while the crew is not working. Please do not move the construction signs as they are owned and maintained by the contractor. In some instances, the signs are being placed in unsafe locations and some are being moved away from the equipment, leaving it unprotected. We have asked the contractor to review signage at the end of each day to ensure it is in the proper location.
- In mid-August, work will begin in the White Oaks neighborhood. Crews will begin by grinding up the existing pavement into gravel on Townes Road and Townes Circle. The roadway will be open during the process, with isolated closures in areas where crews are working.
- Please put your garbage and/or recycling out prior to 7 a.m. on your collection day as haulers are trying to complete their rounds before road work is started for the day.

All schedules are weather-dependent and are subject to change.
