## **Morningside A and White Oaks C Neighborhood Roadway Reconstruction**

Dear Resident:

### **Project Schedule:**

- The final layer of pavement in Morningside and White Oaks is planned for Oct. 31, weather permitting.
- Seeding in Morningside and White Oaks will begin after the first hard frost (dormant seeding). This will protect the seeds from germinating now and allow them to germinate first thing in the spring. The contractor will broadcast seed this fall to augment and improve the turf in the spring. Some areas may need additional work next spring.
- The first layer of pavement is scheduled for Townes Road and Townes Circle today, Friday, Oct. 21. You will not be able to park on the street during this operation. Paving crews move fast and you will be able to drive on the new pavement within 15 minutes after it is compacted with a rolling machine. Paving crews will direct you around the paving operations as required.
- Signs for Sunnyside Road business access are in place directing customers to use the 44<sup>th</sup> Street alley.
- Please put your garbage and/or recycling out prior to 7 a.m. on your collection day as haulers are trying to complete their rounds before road work is started for the day.
