



Morningside B Neighborhood Area Sidewalk Construction

June 17, 2014

Dear Resident:

During the week of June 23, the contractor will begin constructing new sidewalks, as planned, in the area. Crews will begin saw-cutting and removing driveway pavement and concrete driveway aprons on the east side of Crocker Avenue, and along the north side of W. 42nd Street. After this is done, the contractor will build a temporary gravel ramp so that you have access to your driveway.

If this work affects you, a notice will be placed on your front door a day in advance with detailed instructions telling you where to park for the day. Later on, you will be notified again that you cannot access your driveway for approximately five days after the concrete is poured. This is to allow the concrete to harden properly. During this time you will be able to park on the street in front of your home.

Once the work has started, it will take approximately three weeks to complete, weather permitting. If you have an irrigation or pet fence in the boulevard, they may be damaged during construction. Repairs and lawn restoration will be done after the sidewalks are constructed.
