



Normandale Neighborhood Roadway Reconstruction

April 9, 2013

Dear Resident:

During the week of April 8 CenterPoint Energy plans to begin upgrading gas main and gas service lines in the neighborhood. Please contact CenterPoint Energy's Sue Anderson at 612-321-5157 or Larry McGhon at 612-321-5583 with questions.

The City's street contractor, Northwest Asphalt, anticipates starting street reconstruction in the week of May 20 in Stage 1 shown on the map. Effective May 20, when Northwest is on-site, on-street parking is not allowed. This will keep the roadways open for emergency services.

Soon you will receive an invitation to a project-wide late afternoon on-site meeting. This meeting will likely occur during the second week of May. The purpose of the meeting is to acquaint you with Northwest, City, and SEH staff responsible for completing this project.

As CenterPoint and Northwest get underway, please keep in mind the following items.

- During a life or property-threatening emergency, call 9-1-1.
- If your emergency is not life or property-threatening, please call the Edina Police's non-emergency line at 952-826-1600.
- Reconstruction should not affect school bus stop locations.
- Remind your children to stay away from construction sites, construction machinery, and stockpiled materials.
- Please now sign up to receive "City Extra" emails. These emails are our primary way to share project information with you. If you haven't done so already, visit the City of Edina's website at www.EdinaMN.gov to sign up for this free email service.
- If you have a special event planned that is affected by the parking ban, call us. Northwest will work with you the best they can to accommodate your event. Such events could be graduation parties, garage sales, weddings, medical deliveries, home remodeling projects and the like.
- If you chose to hire a private contractor to replace your sanitary sewer service pipe (pipe), they must obtain a permit, complete their work, and obtain a passing inspection by the Building Inspections Division by the dates shown in the map.
- Some property owners are concerned that construction operations might damage their property or home. This rarely happens. However, if you do have concerns, you can hire a

company at your own cost to do a pre-construction survey of your property and home. This survey will cost you about \$500. The survey documents the existing condition of your property or home before construction. If you want a quote for a survey, call Jeff Carlson with Project Works, 763-753-4129, or Jay Houser with Loss Protection Associates, 651-688-0151.
