## Normandale Neighborhood Roadway Reconstruction

Dear Resident:

The following is a quick update of the project in your neighborhood:

### Neighborhood Reconstruction Schedule – Stage 1 (Sherwood and Ryan Avenues, and Parnell Avenue north of 64th Street)

Hydro-seeding of disturbed lawn areas is complete. The contractor will begin periodically watering these areas next week. Please watch your front doors for information on the hydro-seeding process and long-term care tips.

### Neighborhood Reconstruction Schedule – Stage 2 (Parnell Avenue south of 64th Street and West Shore Drive)

Street grading operations will begin Friday and continue next week. From 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., no parking will be allowed on Stage 2 streets. You may park in your driveway as you normally do, but there may be short delays depending on where construction equipment is working. If your driveway will be closed during working hours, the contractor will notify you the night before via a door hanger.

The contractor will begin removing marked concrete curb and driveway aprons next week. If your concrete apron is marked with a white "X," a new apron will be installed.
