Prospect Knolls B / Dewey Hill G Neighborhood Roadway Improvements

Dear Resident:

Project Schedule

The final layer of asphalt is scheduled to be installed on Tuesday, Sept. 29.

Please do not park any vehicles on the street until the roadway has been paved. The entire roadway will need to be clear for crews to work on, clean and pave the roadway.

Just prior to paving, crews will spray the road with a bonding agent. This will help new pavement layer adhere to the existing pavement. This substance is sticky. If you have to drive through it, please drive slowly so it will not track onto your vehicle.

If driven through, the bonding agent can leave wheel tracks in your driveway that the City of Edina will not be responsible for removing or paying for the removal. If you would like to deter other residents from using your driveway as a turnaround, please place your garbage cans at the bottom of your driveway for the day to limit access.

Please do not use irrigation or lawn sprinklers on Tuesday until after the roadway has been paved. This will keep the street dry and allow for a good bond between the old and new layer of blacktop.

Please pass schedule and information on to any personal services or contractors you may have working for you so they can coordinate their schedules accordingly.

Once the new pavement is placed, crews will work with large rollers to compact the new surface in place. If you need to drive on the new street, please go slowly and do not turn sharply as this may leave a lasting mark in the roadway surface.

Remember, on-street parking is still prohibited during working hours. Crews need to access the areas that were seeded to water and perform other maintenance.

All schedules are weather-dependent and are subject to change.
