Strachauer Park A Neighborhood Roadway Improvements

Dear Resident:

Week I of construction is complete. The weather wasn't great for construction so the work on utilities in the neighborhood unfortunately did not start as planned. Crews were still able to complete the reclaiming process for all of Stage I despite the weather.

On-street parking during reconstruction will not be allowed on streets where crews are working. This will keep the streets open for construction traffic and emergency vehicles. We recommend parking in Stage 2 or beyond the construction limits.

- Last week progress was slowed in areas due to contractors parking in the way of crews. Please inform your private contractors and guests of this parking restriction.

On Monday, crews will begin work on the utility repairs and upgrades throughout Stage I.

- Crews plan to start work near the Ewing Avenue and West 60th Street intersection. From there they will work to the South toward West 64th Street throughout the week.
- This work will require road closings and driveway access issues. Please be patient while crews work as efficiently as possible to reopen the roads and driveway access.
- The water main work will require water shut-offs temporarily during the work day.

Crews will also begin driveway and curb removal early next week.

- A gravel ramp will be built at the end of your driveway after removal to allow you access. Please drive slowly when entering and exiting your driveway.
- Please do not park or block the end of your driveway beyond where the saw cut or pink markings are.

Please begin to routinely check your front door for time-sensitive notices for water shut-offs, driveway access, etc.

All schedules are weather-dependent and are subject to change.
