Strachauer Park A Neighborhood Roadway Improvements

Dear Resident:

Construction on Stage I (all streets between Ewing and Chowen Avenues) is set to begin next week!

- On-street parking during reconstruction will not be allowed on streets where crews are working. This will keep the streets open for construction traffic and emergency vehicles. Please inform your private contractors and guests of this parking restriction.
- Tuesday, crews will begin cutting driveways marked for removal. Please avoid parking near the end of your driveway so crews can work in those areas. A temporary gravel ramp will be added to the end of your driveway to allow continued access during construction.
- Wednesday, crews will begin removing the old pavement using a process called reclaiming. The existing pavement will be ground up to produce a gravel product that will be used as a base for the new road. Crews will follow the grinding machine to shape and compact the gravel. The street will remain open, but brief, isolated closures may be needed. Please use caution when driving through these areas.
- Thursday, crews will begin work on utility upgrades and repairs. This may include water shut-offs and limited access to driveways throughout the day.

Please begin to routinely check your front door for time-sensitive notices for water shut-offs, driveway access, etc. All schedules are weather-dependent and are subject to change.
