Tracy Avenue, Valley Lane and Valley View Road Intersection Improvements

Dear Resident:

Project Schedule

Site safety is extremely important during roundabout construction. Please slow down when approaching work zones and share the road with pedestrians, bicyclists and other motorists during construction. Some near misses have occurred due to excessive speeds through the construction zone.

Next week, crews will continue removing pavement, aggregate base and subgrade soils during construction of Phase II on the west side of Valley View Road. After the removals, storm sewer pipe will be extended from Phase I into Phase II. Directing traffic during the storm sewer extension will cause some traffic delay. Once pipe installation is complete, crews will construct the road base and prepare for concrete curbs and gutters and pavement. Residents in this area will have access to their driveways but minor delays may occur. Please use caution when driving through this area as lane shifts have occurred.

CenterPoint Energy plans on installing gas main pipes on Valley View Road and Tracy Avenue near the end of next week. Directing traffic during the gas main pipe installation will cause some traffic delay.

Crews are in the process of constructing a temporary pedestrian and bike path on the east and south sides of Valley View Road and Valley Lane. Path construction is ultimately dependent on utility installation in the area and may be closed infrequently.

Based on the current construction schedule, **Valley Lane will be closed the third week of June for the majority of the project.** Vehicle and pedestrian traffic will need to use alternate routes as the existing pedestrian bridge and box culvert will be removed.

All schedules are weather-dependent and are subject to change.
