W. 70th Street (TH 100 to France Avenue) Reconstruction Project

Dear Residents:

You may have noticed construction activity preparation on W. 70th Street. Construction is scheduled to begin on April 25 and will continue all summer and into the fall. We will send out City Extra updates on a weekly basis.

Advanced Warning Setup

As you are aware, W. 70th Street will be closed to thru traffic and a detour will be set up for the duration of the project. Advanced construction alert signs will be posted on April 8 to inform drivers of the impending detour.

Detour

The detour is set to be in place on Friday, April 22. As stated in a previous correspondence, W. 70th Street will only be closed to thru traffic but you will still be able to access your home during construction. At some point, complete closure of certain segments of W. 70th Street will take place; however, these closures will only take place during the day and reopen to traffic at night. Attempts will be made to keep complete closures to a minimum and we will do our best to ensure affected residents are notified prior to each closure.
