

The Department of Revenue may supply information to the Internal Revenue Service. In addition, this data can be shared by Edina City Staff, Department of Public Safety, Hennepin County Auditor, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension, Hennepin County Warrant Office, Ramsey County Warrant Office and other persons or entities deemed necessary for verification of information submitted in the application. Checklist and Procedures For Peddler & Solicitor Applicants

- Complete the application form (Both sides)
 - One application form per person
 - Do not leave any lines blank. If a question does not apply, enter "N/A".
 - To apply, you must have a current government issued identification card or driver's license.
 - DO NOT SIGN THE APPLICATION NOW. Applications must be signed in front of police department personnel receiving the application.
 - By signing the application the applicant is agreeing to have a background check completed.
 - Any falsification of answers on the application or the application is not completed in its entirety the application will be denied.

- The applicant will supply two (2) recent photographs of himself or herself, approximately 1 1/2" x 1 1/2", at the time the application is submitted.
- Fees: Individual Peddler/Solicitor Permit **\$30.00**. Make check payable to: **Edina Police Department**.
- Return all items to the Edina Police Department.
- Read the Summary of Edina City Ordinance Chapter 12, Article V: Peddlers and Solicitors.

Process:

The police department will attempt to complete the application within 5 business days. Once the application process has been completed, the applicant (or their supervisor) will be contacted to confirm the approval or denial of the application. Upon approval the applicant can pick up their permit/badge at the Edina Police Department, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Summary of Edina City Ordinance Chapter 12, Article V: Peddlers and Solicitors

The City of Edina requires that all Peddlers and Solicitors secure a personal permit prior to beginning business within the City. The Ordinance defines a Peddler as any person with no fixed place of business who goes from residence to residence offering wares or merchandise for sale. A Solicitor is defined as any person who goes from residence to residence soliciting or taking orders for goods or services.

You are required to complete and submit in person to the Edina Police Department an application; describe the type of business and the goods or services you are offering; and, provide a recent photograph. The police department will review your application and upon approval a permit will be issued to you.

The permit is valid for fourteen (14) calendar days, which days must be consecutive and begin within thirty (30) calendar days of the date the permit was issued. You must wear the permit on your person in a visible place.

You also should be aware that Section 12-157 states you may not solicit at any residence that displays a placard at the primary entrance to their home, stating "Peddlers and Solicitors Prohibited".
