

**Dear Participants:**

Welcome to the 47th annual season of Spring skating lessons at Braemar Arena! We ask that you please read the following to make your experience here more enjoyable!

**Arrive:** 15 minutes prior to class time to allow for enough time to get ready.

**Skates:** properly fitted, laced and sharpened with a single blade. Rental skates are available for \$2 each session. We have found that beginners tend to have an easier time in figure skates.

**Apparel:** should be warm and comfortable. Beginning participants are encouraged to wear snow pants and helmets. Don't forget mittens and gloves. Skating dresses or warm-ups are acceptable attire for Jump & Spin & Beginning Synchro. Hockey class participants should have a stick, hockey helmet with a face mask and hockey gloves.

**Check-in:** find your child's name tag on the table in the main lobby. (Wednesday night participants will not have name tags.)

**Skating Parents:** should watch from the bleachers; please do not walk out onto the ice.

**All participants/parents:** If you have questions or concerns, do not hesitate to talk to Shannon or Kristen, who can be identified by their green Braemar Arena fleece jackets (Saturdays only) or stop by the Administration Office. **Class Placement & Evaluation:** placement is based on ability and age. Beginners who are age 3-Kindergarten should register for Tots: Snowplow Sam 1. Beginners who are ages 6-12 should register for Basic Skills 1. If participants pass a level but take a break from skating, they may need to be placed in the level they've already passed in order to refresh their skills. During the last few weeks of each session, each participant will be tested on the skating elements the class has been working on. On the last day, you will be given a written evaluation which will tell you which level to register for in the next session.

**Learn to Skate Curriculum:** we use the United Skates Figure Skating (USFS) Basic Skills Program.

- **Snowplow Sam 1** ( for beginners, ages 3-Kindergarten; skills learned: sit, stand, march, glide & dip in place)
- **Snowplow Sam 2** (for those who have passed Snowplow Sam 1; skills learned: march, glide, hop, dip, backwards wiggles, forward swizzles, rocking horse)
- **Snowplow Sam 3** (for those who have passed Snowplow Sam 2; skills learned: 1 foot glide, forward swizzles, backward swizzles, snowplow stop, curves)
- **Basic 1** (for beginners, ages 6 & up; skills learned: sit, stand, march, hop, glide, dip, swizzles, backward wiggles, snowplow stop, rocking horse)
- **Basic 2** (for those who have passed Snowplow Sam 3 or Basic 1; skills learned: 1 foot glide, backward glide & swizzles, forward to backward turn, snowplow stop, slalom)
- **Basic 3** (for those who have passed Basic 2; skills learned: slalom, 2-foot turn, swizzles in a circle, backward 1 foot glide, 2 foot spin)
- **Basic 4** (for those who have passed Basic 3; skills learned: edges, crossovers, outside three-turns, backward swizzles, backward snowplow stop)
- **Beginning Hockey** (for those who have passed Snowplow Sam 3 or Basic 1; must be able to skate forward, turn & stop independently)
- **Intermediate Hockey** (for those who have completed Beginning Hockey)
- **Jump & Spin** (for those who have passed Basic 4; this advanced class will further develop figure skating skills)
- **Beginning Synchro** (for those who have passed Basic 4; this class introduces skaters to team skating)
- **Adult** (for beginners and those who wish to continue working on their skills)
- **Parent & Child** (for beginners who may be a bit apprehensive to start group lessons and their parents who can skate well enough to hold them up)

**Our Instructors & Ratios:** Our lead skating staff are Professional Skating Association members and are certified by USFS. Our skating ratios range from 6:1 to 12:1 depending on the class level.
