

Edina Site List for 2011-2012

We will be selecting up to twelve works suited to the following sites:

Grandview Square

- Concrete pedestal, 2' dia. x 3' high
- Concrete pedestal, 3' dia. x 2' high
- Ground- level concrete pad, 6' dia. A work that includes a base might be appropriate.

Promenade

- One rectangular pad about 4' x 7'
- Two ground- level concrete pads, 6' dia. A work that includes a base might be appropriate.
- **Site with three 24" dia. concrete pads at ground level spaced in a 10' x 10' x 15' triangle.**

Note:

A set of three pieces or one large piece to fit that spacing will receive strong consideration.

- One paver plaza with 1ft wide concrete curbs -
This plaza is surfaced with pavers that cannot serve as anchors. We have installed pieces with a fairly large footprint anchored to the curb. Conceivably, smaller pieces could be mounted on the curb.
- Other pieces might be installed in the grass along the path if the artist has a way of anchoring them, for example, in the triangle of grass at the gateway to the Promenade where the mosaic chairs have been anchored by their weight.
