CHEERS TO NATIONAL BOURBON HERITAGE MONTH

September is Bourbon Heritage month. Here are some staff recommendations to try:

BASIL HAYDEN'S

This small-batch bourbon is aged 8 years and bottled at 80 proof. Basil uses twice as much rye than others, which gives it a gentle yet spicy flavor with a hint of peppermint. **750 mL, Reg. Price \$36.99, Sale \$31.95**

MAKER'S 46

This bourbon is barrel finished with French oak staves for a bold, complex flavor. It is meticulously handmade and aged during the winter months when bourbon matures more slowly. **750 mL, Reg. Price \$36.99, Sale \$29.95**

MAKER'S MARK

Using red winter wheat instead of rye as the flavoring grain allows for a forward palate and a noticeable and pleasant difference. Maker's Mark has a rich, buttery aroma with hints of raisins and honey. **750 mL, Reg. Price \$25.99, Sale \$21.95**

KNOB CREEK

Booker Noe of Knob Creek fathered the "small-batch bourbon" movement. Renowned for its big, full flavor, extra aging gives this award winner a richer taste. **750 mL, Reg. Price \$32.99, Sale \$25.95**

JIM BEAM WHITE

Jim Beam was founded in 1795 and has been operated by one family for seven generations. The iconic white label brand is the best-selling bourbon in the world. **1 L, Reg. Price \$21.99, Sale \$17.95**

MAKER'S RED TOP

- 1.5 oz Maker's Mark
- Soda water
- Cranberry juice

Fill an old fashioned glass with ice. Add Maker's Mark, soda water and cranberry juice to taste. Stir slightly and garnish with a lime wedge.

BOURBON BYTES:

In 1964, a Congressional Resolution declared Bourbon "**America's Native Spirit.**"

There are more barrels of **bourbon than people** in Kentucky. (Really!)

In a way, George Washington helped invent bourbon. The story goes that in 1789, frontier farmers violently rebelled against their new American government for trying to tax their whiskey.

After Washington squashed the rebellion, disgruntled distillers fled west to—you guessed it—**Kentucky.**



Thomas Jefferson was a huge fan. In fact, he loved bourbon so much he offered farmers 60 acres of prime Kentucky real estate to grow "crops of native origin."

Barrels matter. Barrels are toasted to bring caramelized sugars out of the wood and fired to evenly charcoal the interior. Barrels can only be used one time! Often they are recycled to use for aging Scotch.

The Bottles in Bond Act is considered the first **consumer protection law.** It ensured that in order to be labeled bourbon, the spirit must be 100 proof, aged at least 4 years and not adulterated.
