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*Prerequisite: Must have taken Beginning Hockey and/or must be able to skate forward well and backwards somewhat.

Participants Should Come Prepared With:

- * **Skates**– must be properly fitted, sharpened and single-bladed. Beginners tend to learn better in figure skates, but hockey skates are acceptable. Hockey skates are required for Beginning and Power Hockey. Figure skates are required for Jump & Spin. A limited number of rental skates are available for \$2 per pair, per session, on a first come, first served basis.
- * **Mittens or gloves**– hockey gloves are preferred for the Beginning and Power Hockey classes.
- * **Warm & comfortable clothing**– beginning level Tots participants are encouraged to wear snow pants, otherwise, long pants and a jacket or sweatshirt are sufficient; Jump & Spin participants are encouraged to wear figure skating attire.
- * **Helmets**– are strongly recommended for beginning skaters of all ages. Hockey helmets are preferred, but properly fitted bike or ski helmets are acceptable. Hockey helmets with a face mask are required for Beginning and Power Hockey participants.
- * **Hockey Stick**– this applies to Beginning and Power Hockey participants only.
