



CITY OF EDINA ABOVE-GROUND POOL REGULATIONS

Edina City Code, Section 450 allows above-ground pools subject to the following requirements:

- **The above-ground pool is temporary and must be stored indoors between October 15th and April 15th.**
- **The pool is no larger than 255 square feet and no deeper than 48 inches.**
- **Safety equipment must be present including a ring buoy with 15 feet of line attached or shepherds crook not less than 10 feet in length.**
- **The pool must be located in the rear yard, no closer than five (5) feet to the side property line and ten (10) feet to the rear property line.**
- **A fence is required. The pool must be completely enclosed by a non-climbable, rot resistant fence with a minimum height requirement of four (4) feet.**
- **If gates are present they must be self-closing and self-latching. Vertical slates shall be no more than four (4) inches and have no more than a four (4) inch gap between the ground and the bottom of the fence. Posts must be set in concrete.**
- **Drainage shall be either to the sanitary sewer or onto the property where the pool is located, and not onto adjoining properties.**
- **State Electrical Codes apply: Electrical lines shall be no closer than ten (10) feet from the pool.**

A building permit is not required. An inspection is not required. A deck is not required.
