**Purpose:** Provide information on plumbing permit fees and sample fee calculation

**Scope:** All plumbing permits

**Plumbing Permit Fee Schedule**

\$0 - \$300	*\$15
\$301 - \$700	*\$15 plus 1.75% > \$300
\$701 - \$1,000	*\$22.00 plus 3.10% > \$700
\$1,001 - \$5,000	*\$31.50 plus 2.60% > \$1,000
\$5,001 - \$10,000	*\$135.50 plus 2.15% > \$5,000
\$10,001 - \$25,000	*\$243.00 plus 1.85% > \$10,000
\$25,001 - \$50,000	*\$520.50 plus 1.65% > \$25,000
\$50,001 and over	*\$933.00 plus 1.30% > \$50,000

\*Plus surcharge pursuant to M.S. 16B.70

Note: Minimum fee for Residential Permits with surcharge included is \$15.50

Note: Minimum fee for Commercial Permits with surcharge included is \$27.50

**Permit Fee Calculation Example**

Example: Contract price of \$750.00  
 \$701 - \$1,000            \$22.00 + 3.10% of anything over \$700  
                                  \$700.00 is \$22.00 + 3.10% of \$50.00  
                                  or \$22.00 + \$1.55 = \$23.55

**State Surcharge Calculation Example**

Example: Contract price of \$750.00  
 .0005 multiplied by the contract price, or minimum of \$ .50  
 .0005 x \$750.00 = \$ .38 or minimum of \$ .50

**Total permit fee for this example is \$23.55 + \$ .50 = \$24.05**

Contract price or job cost means the actual or estimated dollar amount charged for the permitted work including materials, labor, profit, and other fixed costs. It is the amount to be charged to the customer for the work to be done. If the owner, tenant or any other party furnishes any material, equipment, labor, or installation, the reasonable market value of such items must be added to the estimated cost or contract price for permit fee purposes. In the event that there is a dispute on the amount of the job cost, the City may request the submission of a signed copy of the actual contract.
